Preferred file types QuarkXpress (Apple Macintosh), Photoshop, PDF or Illustrator files. When supplying PDF or EPS formats please ensure all fonts are embedded. All files must be at least 300dpi. All colour digital files are to be supplied with colour guide (eg. cromalin).

Trap information White text (on a coloured background) and graphic elements should always be set to 'Knock-out' and not overprint.
